PRIVACY POLICY

BarIssues.com is committed to respecting the privacy rights of our subscribers. This Privacy Policy explains what kinds of information we collect through our website located at www.barissues.com, how we use that information in connection with our service, and how we protect your personal information.

What information do we collect?

We collect information from you when you register on our website, subscribe to our newsletter, or respond to a survey. When subscribing to our service, you may be asked to enter your name, e-mail address, mailing address, and information about your law school or anticipated bar exam dates. You may, however, visit our site anonymously.

What do we use your information for?

Any of the information we collect from you may be used in one of the following ways:

- **To improve our website**. We continually strive to improve our website offerings based on the information and feedback we receive from you.
- **To improve customer service**. Your information helps us to more effectively respond to your requests and support needs.
- **To process transactions**. Your information, whether public or private, will not be sold, exchanged, transferred, or given to any other company for any reason whatsoever, without your consent, other than for the express purpose of delivering the service you purchase.
- **To send periodic emails**. The email address you provide may be used to send you information and updates pertaining to your subscription, in addition to occasional company news and bar exam related information. However, if at any time you would like to unsubscribe from receiving future emails, we include detailed unsubscribe instructions at the bottom of each email.

How do we protect your information?

We implement a variety of security measures to maintain the safety of your personal information when you place an order or enter, submit, or access your personal information.

We offer the use of a secure server. All supplied sensitive/credit information is transmitted via Secure Socket Layer (SSL) technology and then encrypted into our payment gateway provider's database only to be accessible by personnel authorized with special access rights to such systems, who are required to keep the information confidential.

Your private information (credit card, PayPal login, etc.) will not be stored on our servers.

Do we use cookies?

Depending on how you're accessing our services, we may use "cookies" (a small text file sent by your computer each time you visit our website, unique to your BarIssues.com account or your browser), or similar technologies to record log data. When we use cookies, we may use "session" cookies (that last until you close your browser) or "persistent" cookies (that last until you or your browser delete them). Some of the cookies we use are associated with your BarIssues.com account (including personal information about you, such as the email address you gave us), and other cookies are not.

Do we disclose any information to outside parties?

We do not sell, trade, or otherwise transfer to outside parties your personally identifiable information. This does not include trusted third parties who assist us in operating our website, so long as those parties agree to keep this information confidential. We may release your information when appropriate to comply with the law, enforce our website policies, or when reasonably necessary to protect our or another's property rights or safety. Anonymous, non-personally identifiable visitor information may be provided to other parties for marketing, advertising, or other uses.

We will not distribute your personal information to outside parties without your consent. Some web browsers incorporate a "Do Not Track" feature that signals to websites that you visit that you do not want to have your online activity tracked. How browsers communicate the Do Not Track signal is not yet uniform. For this reason, our Website does not currently interpret, respond to or alter its practices when it receives Do Not Track signals. Please note that third parties may collect information about your online activities over time and across different websites when you visit our website or other websites and services.
